WHEREAS, Rocky Mountain Power estimates a 3,000 megawatt shortage by 2016 in Utah alone; and,

WHEREAS, environmental lobby has stopped the building of any more coal fired power plants; and,

WHEREAS, in economic recession job creation is important; and,

WHEREAS, HB 440 would hinder nuclear power expansion,

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved that the City of Green River opposes HB 440 and supports the expansion of nuclear energy.
