

investigate such matters: "If the state engineer ... has reason to believe that an application to appropriate water will unreasonably affect public recreation or the natural stream environment ... it is the state engineer's duty to withhold approval or rejection of the application until the state engineer has investigated the matter." Utah Code Ann. §73-3-8 (1) (b) (i).

The discharge of significantly warmer water from a once-through system or water concentrated with salts from a closed-loop system could unreasonably affect the natural stream environment. For the reasons indicated above, we believe this application could also prove detrimental to the public welfare.

IV. Hearing

We respectfully request a hearing on change application a35402 relating to water right 89-74.

V. Conclusion

Wherefore, we request that the change application a35402 be rejected in its current state.
