Part 4, hereby file a timely Notice of Appeal regarding the acceptance of the August 3, 2009, Denison Mines (USA) Corporation minor mine plan modification for the Pandora Mine (UTU 69800), signed by the Acting Moab Field Office Manager, A. Lynn Jackson, September 10, 2009. This agency action was not the subject of a public notice. Appellants received the agency decision on June 11, 2010. This Notice of Appeal is timely because it is within 30 days of June 11, 2010, accounting for the weekend. Uranium Watch, Living Rivers, and Red Rock Forests will file a Statement of Reasons and Argument within 30 days of filing this document, pursuant to 43 C.F.R. §§ 4.411-413, along with supporting documents.
