

The applicant has not met the burden of proof as required by Utah law for a water change application; the application should be rejected in its current form, or at least not approved until the applicant provides substantially more information. We incorporate herein the previous protest concerning use of a companion water right and also adopt the protests of other interested persons and water rights holders who object to this Application.

V. Hearing

The Utah Rivers Council requests a hearing on the change application filed by the District for water right 09-462.

VI. Conclusion

Wherefore, The Utah Rivers Council respectfully request that the State Engineer reject or investigate the change application. The applicant has failed to meet its burden of convincing the State Engineer that all statutory requirements under Utah Code Ann. §73-3-8 (1) have been met.
